Inclusion by Restorative Justice

Restorative Justice is a process where people affected by an injustice come together to work on the causes and consequences of the injustice as well as possible solutions to repair the harm inflicted. Victims, offenders, social network and the community have an active role in explaining the real impact of the offense and damage done by imprisonment. And find a way to actually restore justice. Restorative justice repairs the harm caused by crime and detention. When victims, social network, offenders and community members meet to decide how to do that, the results can be transformational. It emphasizes accountability, making amends, and – if they are interested – facilitated meetings between victims, offenders, and other persons. And gives all actors to restore their lives.
